

Altensteig at Nagold valley (15 km)

The small town Altensteig with its medieval centre, fortress and castle is an ideal destination for persons interested in culture. The outdoor swimming pool invites you on hot summer days. Reachable by bus.

Reichental (15 km)

At the small, idyllic mountain village situated at the slopes of the Murg valley below the Hohloh massif you will find one of the most beautiful open-air swimming pools in our area with a wonderful view at the surrounded mountains and valleys and a little museum.

Reservoir of the river Nagold: the „Erzgrube“ (19 km)

Located within the delightful valley of the river Nagold the reservoir extends along a 2 km stretch. In summer the lake invites for swimming, diving, surfing, boating and is recommended to families with children. Nearby you can have a close experience with nature in the **barefoot park (BarfussPark) Dornstetten-Hallwangen**.

Freudenstadt (25 km)

Situated on a wide open plateau (altitude 700-1000 m) the climatic health resort is known for its expanded market place which is skirted by arcades. There, on rainy days the tourists can go for a walk or may visit a coffee house. Worth seeing is furthermore the ExperienceMuseum EXPERIMENTA, a museum for interaction, to join in and to try out, a museum for the whole family as well as the famous PanoramaBad with its numerous possibilities for bathing or having a sauna. Reachable with free public service bus.

Rotfelden (Ebhausen) at Nagold valley (25 km)

Situated in idyllic country side the **camel park Rotfelden** represents a unique adventurous spot throughout Europe with over 70 camels.

Gernsbach at Murg valley (27 km)

The old town in northern Baden also called the „pearl of the Murg valley“ offers to its visitors a spectacular historic town centre with impressive remains of the old city wall as well as comfortable pavement cafés. Above the town the beautiful castle **Eberstein** is situated which is also worth seeing it.

Calw und Hirsau (28 km)

The thoroughly restored old part of the formerly most important trade and commercial centre of Württemberg with its numerous half-timbered houses is worth a visit. In the neighboring, impressive ruin of the monastery complex of Hirsau open-air concerts are given in July and August. Reachable with free public service bus.

Black Forest Panoramic Mountain-Road (35 km)

Starting at Baden-Baden, the panoramic road „Schwarzwald-Hochstraße“ runs along the main mountain range of the northern Black Forest to Freudenstadt. At the mountain road (altitude 1000 m) the famous lake „Mummelsee“, the „Ruhestein“ pass and the „Kniebis“ massif are located.

Pforzheim (36 km)

In the **goldtown** Pforzheim with its **Jewellery Museum** and its exhibition **Schmuckwelten** exists a very interesting and beauty spot for families with children: the spacious **game park** (over 15 hectare). A lot of native as well as exotic species are living there like lynx, wild boar, bison, deer, wild horse or lama.

Baden-Baden (40 km)

Once being the meeting place of the European crowned heads, the world-famous spa town with its palaces, villas and magnificent hotels today has still kept much of the glory of the Belle Epoch. The classicistic Kurhaus represents one of the most beautiful, famous and oldest casinos in the world. Furthermore, the „Caracalla-Thermen“ invites you to a luxurious bathing experience.

Alpirsbach (40 km)

15 km to the south of Freudenstadt the town Alpirsbach shows a unique historic monument of the Black Forest in the shape of the Romance monastery church which was built during the 11th century by Benedictine monks. Nowadays concerts are given inside the church.

Wolf- and Bear Park in Rippoldsau-Schapach (45 km)

In the wolf and bear park you can take a closer look at these proud animals. Open the whole year.

Karlsruhe (50 km)

Karlsruhe, the capital of Baden, is situated at the northern end of the Black Forest within the Rhine valley. All streets of the town are running fan-shaped towards the castle which is a wonderful building like its example at Versaille.

Tübingen on the Neckar (60 km)

In the Neckar valley nearby the Swabian Jura the old University town Tübingen is situated. The vast number of students and the thoroughly restored medieval centre gives to the small town an unmistakable charm mixed of old architecture. The famous castle **Hohenzollern** nearby the town Hechingen is located 25 km to the south of Tübingen.

Traditional Black Forest farmhouses in the Gutach valley (65 km)

In the valleys of the rivers Gutach, Wolfach and Kinzig in the middle Black Forest region the old traditional farmhouses are still present. In the Gutach valley the 430 years old farmhouse „Vogtsbauernhaus“ represent the center of a very interesting open-air museum.

Triberg (85 km)

Nearby the town Triberg, which is also called the „pearl of the middle Black Forest“ region, the highest waterfalls in Germany are located. Through a narrow gorge over seven cascades and 163 meters difference in altitude the water of the river Gutach is falling down to the valley basin. On planks and footbridges the gorge can be discovered.

Straßburg (90 km)

Not only the famous cathedral and the impressive mediaeval centre are so special about the capital of Alsace but also the mixture of French charm and Alemannic tradition.

Europa Park in Rust (100 km)

The widely known amusement park Rust is located in the Rhine valley to the south of the town Offenburg. It will lead you into a breathtaking world of fairytales with whitewater slide, haunted house, knight's games, ice show as well as many other attractions for young and older people.

Leisure-time activities and excursions at and around Enzklösterle

A **sunny playground for children** offering different equipments like a seesaw, a swing, table tennis is situated on the car-free tent-area. Nearby a small mountain brook invites you to **splash around** and to make a hydro-therapy **in clear spring water**. Your obligatory guest card can be used as a free ticket **for the public service busses** for example to Bad Wildbad, Calw or Freudenstadt. On account of the central location of the campsite *Müllerwiese* within Enzklösterle there are **numerous possibilities of leisure-time activities nearby**. You can race down a mountainside, explore the forest from lofty treetops and gain a completely new perspective on golf. With lots of skills the river's current can be navigated, followed by a voluntary plunge into one of the outdoor swimming pools nearby. Further details on those activities marked by " * " are available at the Tourist Information Enzklösterle.

Activities for children and teenager ☀️☁️🌧️🌩️

Adventure-Golfpark: The new breathtaking crazy golf course experience. Play on 18 Black Forest typical courses. (500m from Campingplatz *Müllerwiese*)

Forest climbing garden: 2 - 14 m high climbing paths through the Black Forest trees is an adventure for young and old. (500m from Campingplatz *Müllerwiese*).

Red Deer Park: In the Red Deer Park you can take a closer look at a true Black Forest stag. (500m from Campingplatz *Müllerwiese*)

Barefoot trail: Visiting the barefoot trail, located at the spa garden of Enzklösterle, is fun especially for children's feet. The „Kneipp“-pool is right next to it.

Ball Park * : At the ball park near the gymnasium the guest children are invited to play volleyball, handball or football/soccer.

Giant toboggan run: A thrilling slide down a giant toboggan run in Enzklösterle-Poppeltal (5 km, reachable by public bus for free) will be an experience. Can you resist one of the longest toboggan runs in Germany, 1500 m long? With a big drag lift you reach the height of the „Seekopf“ and during the downhill run on a bobsled you are passing five steep turns.
